## PARISH COUNCIL MEETING REPORT

The most recent parish council meeting was held in the village hall in March and speeding traffic continues to be a concern, the figures from our mobile Speed Device show that in the period January to March 15<sup>th</sup> over 92,000 vehicles travelled through with over 52,000 doing more than the 30mph speed limit. A rotten styal has been reported on a public path. Our next village clean up event will take place on 7<sup>th</sup> May and more details will be sent out via social media. The parish council will coordinate an event for the Queen's platinum Jubilee and this will be held at the Village Hall on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June with a BBQ, afternoon tea and cake, garden games and it is also hoped that we can arrange a Jubilee themed scarecrow display – if you are interested in helping with this event please contact Karen [clerk.westashby@gmail.com](mailto:clerk.westashby@gmail.com)
