## PARISH COUNCIL MEETING REPORT

The most recent meeting was held in the village hall in November and we discussed recent speed data provided by our CSW team, we co-opted a new parish councillor Mrs Annie Radcliffe, a report was provided by our District Councillor Mr David Andrews the Chairman was able to advise that the new bank mandate is being resolved in the next two weeks. A successful litter pick and bulb planting took place last month and more brash has been cleared from and bulbs planted in the layby. A family quiz has been set up and funds from this are to pay for more floral displays in 2022. It is expected that a new one tonne bag of grit will be delivered by LCC later this month which will help to keep our footpaths clear in severe cold weather. The clerk will also write to ELDC to express our interest in developing a neighbourhood plan. It was also confirmed that gates to be placed at the entrance to the village have been purchased and are being painted ready for installation. A water supply for the cemetery was also discussed and water harvesting options are to be explored further before any action is taken.
