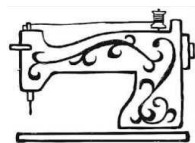

COOKS CORNER

CHERRY BAKEWELL SPONGE PUDDING

2 X 425 cans of pitted black cherries in syrup
 50g self-raising flour
 6 tbsp cherry jam
 140g ground almonds
 200g butter, softened
 1tsp almond extract
 200g golden caster sugar
 50g flaked almonds
 3 large eggs
 icing sugar for dusting

1. Heat the oven to 180C/160C fan/Gas mark 4
2. Boil the syrup from the cherries and the jam in a pan for 10 -15 minutes until reduced by half and is thick and syrupy. Then stir in the cherries, pour into a 18 x 25cm baking dish and set aside.
3. Mix the butter, sugar, eggs, flour, ground almonds and almond essence by hand or electric whisk to combine. Pour the mixture over the cherries and spread to form a smooth layer, trying not to disturb the fruit below. Scatter over the flaked almonds and bake for 45 mins or until a skewer inserted into the sponge layer comes out clean.
4. Leave to cool for 5 mins then dust with icing sugar. Serve with cream or custard.
